

OKANOGAN COUNTY

ORDINANCE NO. 2000-4

AN ORDINANCE relating to a speed limit on the following Okanogan County Roads:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKANOGAN COUNTY:

Section 1

This ordinance is enacted in exercise of the "Rules of the Road," Chapter 46.61 R.C.W., pertaining to Speed Restrictions, specifically, 46.61.415 R.C.W., titled, "When local authorities may alter maximum limits," for the protection and preservation of the health and safety of the public.

Section 2

The speed limit for all motor vehicles is set as stated below for portions of the following County Roads:

O.C.R. 9155, Old 97 Highway

25 M.P.H. beginning at milepost 14.20 and continuing through Malott to milepost 14.80.

O.C.R. 1933, Okanogan St

25 M.P.H. beginning at milepost 0.00 at the intersection with O.C.R. 1960, North Malott Road and continuing to milepost 0.46 at the intersection with O.C.R. 9155, Old 97 Highway.

O.C.R. 9165, B & O Road

25 M.P.H. beginning at milepost 0.00 at the intersection of SR 97 and continuing to milepost 0.93.

Section 3

The restrictions imposed by Section 2 of this ordinance shall become effective upon installation of appropriate signs at the specified road locations stating the speed limit established. After installation of such signs it shall be unlawful for anyone to drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of the speed limit established by Section 2 of this Ordinance, except as authorized by Chapter 46.61.425(1) R.C.W.

Section 4

The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to become effective immediately upon lawful approval and passage by the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County.
