

OKANOGAN COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS' ORDINANCE NO. 2006 - 8

AN ORDINANCE relating to speed limits on the following Okanogan County Roads:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF OKANOGAN COUNTY:

Section 1

This ordinance is enacted in exercise of the "Rules of the Road," Chapter 46.61 R.C.W., pertaining to Speed Restrictions, specifically, 46.61.415 R.C.W., titled, "When local authorities may alter maximum limits," for the protection and preservation of the health and safety of the public.

Section 2

The speed limit for all motor vehicles is set as stated below on all of the following Okanogan County Roads:

O.C.R. No. 3175, Rodeo Trail Road No. from the Okanogan City Limits to just past the Sports Complex, specifically, M.P. 0.60 to M.P. 0.90: a speed limit of 35 M.P.H.;

O.C.R. No. 1020, McFarland Creek Road, from the intersection with SR 153 to the end of the pavement, specifically M.P. 0.00 to M.P. 0.88: a speed limit of 35 M.P.H.

Section 3


The restrictions imposed by Section 2 of this Ordinance shall become effective upon erection of appropriate signs at the specified road locations stating the speed limit established. After erection of such signs it shall be unlawful for anyone to drive a motor vehicle at a speed in excess of the speed limit established by Section 2 of this Ordinance. Any person exceeding the lawful speed established by this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 4


The provisions of this Ordinance are intended to become effective immediately upon lawful approval and passage by the Board of County Commissioners of Okanogan County.


