ORDINANCE NO. 2013 - 5

REPEALING AND AMENDING SECTIONS OF OKANOGAN COUNTY CODE (OCC) 12.90
VACATION AND COMPENSATION FOR COUNTY ROADS

WHEREAS, it is necessary and prudent to periodically review, update and revise the Okanogan County Code (OCC), and;

WHEREAS, current OCC Section 12.90.020 contains a typo and current OCC Section 12.90.030 needs amendment to reflect current practice, and

WHEREAS, as required by law, publication of the Public Hearing notice was placed in the newspaper of record and the Board of Okanogan County Commissioners held the Public Hearing on May 14, 2013, and heard all parties interested on said amendments;


NOW, THEREFORE; BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for Okanogan County:

Section 1. Chapter 12.90 of the Okanogan County Code (OCC), "Vacation and Compensation for County Roads," is hereby amended as shown in Exhibit A, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, with all other sections remaining in full force and effect.


Section 2. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be May 14th, 2013.



Exhibit A

12.90.020 Classification

The board of county commissioners (hereinafter referred to as "the board") herein classifies all roads in and under the jurisdiction of the county as follows:

- A. All county roads which have had public expenditures made for acquisitions, improvement, or maintenance of them consisting of all those roads comprising the county road system; and
- B. All county roads which are legally county roads but are not formally on the county road system, regardless of expenditures made for acquisition, improvement or maintenance of them, these roads being acquired in any of the following manners;
 - 1. By deed, or
 - 2. By dedication, or
 - 3. By prescription;
- C. All county roads which are under subsections A or B, and for which the right-of-way was obtained by donation or by a combination of donation and prescription, and for which the original donee(s) donor would be benefiting party(s) in the event of a vacation.

12.90.030 Expenditures of record

The type and amount of expenditures made and the nature of the county's property interest in any road shall be determined by the official records of the county road division office of the Okanogan County Engineer and is are incorporated in this chapter by reference.
