ORDINANCE NO. 2014 -3

*REPEALING OKANOGAN COUNTY ORDINANCE 2013-9 AND 2013-10
RELATING TO THE OPERATION OF OFF-ROAD VEHICLES ON COUNTY ROADS*

WHEREAS, Okanogan County adopted Ordinance 2013-9, an amendment to the list of County Roads open for Off-Road vehicles, on July 25, 2013, and;

WHEREAS, it appears Ordinance 2013-9 conflicts with RCW 46.09, and;

WHEREAS, Okanogan County adopted Ordinance 2013-9, amending Chapter 10.10 of the Okanogan County Code and opening roads for Off-Road vehicle use, and;

WHEREAS, it appears Ordinance 2013-9 suffers from minor procedural deficiencies that need to be remedied prior to its implementation.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners for Okanogan County:

Section 1. Okanogan County Ordinance 2013-9 and Okanogan County Ordinance 2013-10 are rescinded and repealed in full.


Section 2. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon signing and filing with the Okanogan County Auditor.
