## **PLEASE NOTE:**

- 1. Public consumption of alcoholic beverage or drugs on fairgrounds property is not permitted.
- 2. The spaces for RVs are 12' x 30'. We are required to keep 10 feet between units for safety reasons. You must keep everything within your space (including tents and ropes.) Oversized camping units will be assigned to outside the south fence (South Out).
- 3. If you are planning to put more than one (1) form of accommodations within your space, you must have prior approval.
- 4. There will be quiet time in the RV Park from 11:00pm until 6:00am. Please be respectful of these times.
- 5. There SHALL be adult supervision at each leased site during the entire Fair. Adults are expected to provide good examples for youth, both in speech and in action.
- 6. ABSOLUTELY NO ANIMALS OF ANY KIND allowed at any time in the camping areas. NO DOGS are allowed on Fairgrounds property.
- 7. NO Bicycles, Scooters, Skateboards, Roller Blades/Skates, Lasers, Toy Guns, or any other item that may be considered dangerous or a nuisance these are NOT allowed on the Fairgrounds.
- 8. FIRE LANES MUST BE KEPT OPEN AND UNOBSTRUCTED AT ALL TIMES.
- AIR CONDITIONERS MAY NOT BE USED AT ANY TIME Circuits will overload and inconvenience all.
- 10. \*\*\*South End Electrical will need to have a 10 gauge minimum 50ft extension cord for new electrical outlets.
- 11. Camping space assignments will be determined by the Fair Camping Committee and are subject to change or be cancelled at any given time. The Okanogan County Fair is not responsible for theft, fire, or damage to any camping units, including tents and personal property of any kind. In addition, by September 18<sup>th</sup> (the first Friday following the Fair), any camping unit left beyond that date will be charge a \$25/per night RV fee. If such vehicle is left unattended and fees are not paid in advance, after one additional week (September 25<sup>th</sup>), any unit remaining will be towed at the owner's expense. The demand for camping space during Fair time has grown. We will try our best to fill your request, but understand you may not receive your requested space. We want everyone to have a great experience at the Fair. Please help us by returning your application as soon as possible. Late applications will be placed according to available space; no exceptions.

## \*\*SPECIAL NOTE\*\*

Due to longer RVs and more tip-outs, please be honest with your measurements. We will try to accommodate some larger RVs, but space is limited and we cannot do so without truthful information.

Dogs have become an increasingly large problem at the Fair and it must be kept under control. This starts with you! Please do not bring your dog(s) to the Fair as they have become a nuisance. Regardless of how amazing your dog is, we cannot welcome your pet. In the event you do not respect this rule, you will be asked nicely to take your pet home. If the dog remains on Fairgrounds property, we may be forced to contact animal control for dogs wandering around the property. Please do not allow it to get this far, by valuing this rule and leaving your pet at home.

Early parking will not be tolerated. The Fairgrounds are scheduled for a certain time period for the annual Fair. If you bring your vehicle or RVs early, they will be towed at the owner's expense.
