Re: Dismissal of Voter Registration Challenge for Nick Timm submitted September 27, 2024 Dear Naomie Peasley,

After reviewing the Voter Registration Challenge for Nick Timm submitted on September 27, 2024, I am dismissing this challenge. This Voter Registration Challenge does not meet the requirements under RCW 29A.08.810(1)(c) for challenging a voter registration based on allegations that Nick Timm does not reside at the voter registration address listed in the challenge form.

The statute provides:

(1) Registration of a person as a voter is presumptive evidence of his or her right to vote. A challenge to the person's right to vote must be based on personal knowledge of one of the following:

. . .

(c) The challenged voter resides at a different address than the residential address provided

. . .

Per RCW 29A.08.840(1) if the challenge is not in proper form or the factual basis for the challenge does not meet the legal grounds for a challenge, the county auditor may dismiss the challenge and notify the challenger of the reasons for the dismissal.

Nick Timm is not registered to vote at the address you listed as his registered voter address on the challenge form. Therefore, the factual basis for this challenge does not meet the legal grounds for a challenge and I am dismissing the challenge per RCW 29A.08.840(1).
