55 **Quarterly Update-OBHC-David McClay, Dennis Rabidou**

58 Mr. McClay provided the OBHC quarterly report, in accordance with the contract between OBHC  
59 and the county. Mr. McClay said OBHC is having a difficult time retaining employees. He is looking  
60 at ways to retain employees, but how is still to be determined. Mr. McClay added there is a lot of  
61 COVID money available and OBHC is looking at applying for loss of revenue due to COVID.  
62 OBHC received \$100,000 from Beacon to help deal with Designated Crisis Responders (DCR.)  
63 Looking at ways to utilize the funds.

65 OBHC is working on its Intensive Mobile Crisis Team to get case managers out in the community  
66 to proactively engage with the 50 or so frequent callers. Mr. McCray has met with Sheriff Hawley  
67 to talk about their roles in addressing the new laws such as the Blake Decision and HB 1054, HB  
68 1310, and SB 5476 to try and figure out how to approach these situations.
