**Incarcerated Individual Money**

Incarcerated individuals may use money for various products and services provided at the Orleans County Jail. Incarcerated individuals are afforded the opportunity to purchase commissary products, pay for telephone services and pay for services provided on electronic tablets.

Family and friends will be allowed to provide money to incarcerated individuals through the following methods:

1. Money orders may be send in the mail directly to the incarcerated individual. The Orleans County jail does not recommend sending cash through the postal service.
2. Money may be added to the incarcerated individual's account using the Kiosk located in the lobby of the Orleans County Jail.
3. Money may be added directly to an incarcerated individuals account using the Access Corrections link at <https://www.accesscorrections.com/>
4. Money can also be added directly to the phone and table service providers:
  - a. Tablet System - <https://www.gettingout.com/>
  - b. Telephone System - <https://icsolutions.com/>
  - c. Mobile apps are available for the tablet system using an Android or Apple IOS.
5. Money is not authorized to be transferred from one incarcerated individual to another.
6. All transactions are monitored by the facility. Any misuse of the jail banking systems may result in a suspension of products and or services.
