1. Annual Household HazardouseWaste Collection Event	J. Bensley	In keeping with annual popularity and tradition, J. Bensley proposed the 2023 HHW Collection Event to be held on Saturday August 12th at the County highway garage. No Committee members objected. J. Welch suggested J. Papponnetti be contacted for assurance that newconstruction would not interfere. E. Morgan asked if DPW staff was available to load roll-offs with tires to avoid the expensive grappler of Modern Disposal.	
2. Municipal impact: Governor's housing growth targets	J. Bensley	The Governor had just proposed a new policy to create more affordable housing. J. Bensley stated it he would monitor it closely, as lack of compliance by municipalities to meet growth mandates could result in interventionism by NYS to approve projects that would not comply with rigid municipal zoning. This may take four years before drastic provisions are implemented by NYS.	
3. Rochester Genesee Regional Transportation Authority (RGRTA)	J. Bensley	The latest reports from RGRTA indicated RTS Orleans ridership had risen in the last quarter of 2022. On-time performance was also excellent recently. J. Bensley noted that the RGRTA just recently agreed to purchase hydrogen fuel cell high electric headroom vans for Monroe County at this time. The vans would each cost approximately 3 times higher than the diesel version, but grant assistance helped, and these were expected to require less cost of maintenance.	
4. Upcoming Meetings/Events	J. Bensley	Future meetings and events for J. Bensley are G/FL County Planning Directors on February 10th (virtual); RGRTA Comprehensive Plan Review on February 16th (Rochester), and G/FL Regional Planning Council on February 23rd (Rochester or virtual).
