Chairman Johnson called the public hearing to order at 4:26 p.m.

Clerk Stenshorn read the published legal notice.

Chairman Johnson asked Real Property Director, Dawn Allen to provide an overview of the proposed Local Law to Revise Income Eligibility Levels for the Disabled.

Dawn Allen stated this exemption is a sliding scale starting at \$19,000.00 for a 50% exemption, capping out at a 5% exemption for an income of \$27,399.99. This exemption is for persons on limited incomes and disabled. We like to keep this exemption in line with the Senior Exemption because, once the person turns 65 years of age they convert to the Senior Exemption.

Chairman asked three times for any public comment.

With there being no public comment, Chairman Johnson closed the Public Hearing at 4:29 p.m.
