Kelly Brown – I had emailed the board earlier this year regarding possible solutions to fix this. I even sent comments from Facebook. We need a Township Page to communicate to the community. I feel this would be an amazing way to update the public on meetings and notices. I would like to recommend another police officer be hired as the community needs it. Nancy Roy – On the front of the agenda could you list what the initials mean for the public. Ordinance revisions and readings. What does that mean, should you be putting it up on the screen? We do not have the whole packet like you do. I have many questions about the revisions passed tonight. I think you need to look at the number of tiny homes up to 5 acres that can be built with 20 per acre.

<u>Mr. Wusterbarth</u>- We should do something for Sue Allor for all her work for the community and securing funding. Also, we should do something for Nancy as we are coming up to her retirement.

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Mr. Cummings- I am proud of my time that I have served as representative for the community on the RAB board. I think we have done a good job but, communication as Mr. Sutton brought up because we can't keep having these situations pop up. When people say they have brought a comment to the board, and it is being ignored. It concerns me as I do not see them always. If you feel that is the case, send it to the whole board.
