
Summer sure took it's time to arrive this year...with the cool spring temperatures the hanging baskets and plantings were delayed by about 2 weeks...but by the first week in June Downtown Oscoda was overflowing with beautiful bright colored flowers everywhere! After bitter arctic temperatures this winter we are looking forward to an exciting season filled with fun, friendship and family! As we welcome people into our community to experience what we get to enjoy every day we would like to take this opportunity to mention a few of the exciting projects and activities underway and those yet to be completed this summer.

Oscoda Beach Park - Oscoda Township and Oscoda Lions have partnered to fund construction of a Splash Pad project that should be up and running by early July! The approximate 300 sq foot pad will feature 3 above ground fixtures and 4 flush ground nozzles that will allow children another way to cool down and have fun this summer. The splash pad will be located in the middle of the park adjacent to the bathroom facilities. The cost of this project is approximately \$20,000 and would not have been possible without the generous donation from the Oscoda Lions to provide funding for half of the project costs (\$10,000).

This amenity is sure to be a crowd pleaser once the hot

summer gets underway!

Another improvement scheduled to occur this summer at the Beach Park are new steel ramps for the skateboard park. Oscoda Township was successful



in obtaining a Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund Recreation Passport Grant in the amount of \$42,000 (\$25,200 in grant funds and a local match of \$16,800 from the Township General Fund). The overall project will consist of all new ramps and features for the existing slab as well as a concrete retaining wall that will be installed along the East side of the pad to serve the dual purpose of both seating and protection from blowing sand.

Permits are free of charge, there is a 3 day limit on the number of sequential days you may hold your sale and there is a limit of a total of 4 sales per year per address. *You may register to vote at the Clerk's Office any day Monday – Friday 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.

mation such as meeting agendas, minutes and packets are available to view and once enrolled, an email alert is sent every time a new document is added with a corresponding link to that document. TOWNSHIP ZONING PERMITS

As a reminder, Oscoda Township is a zoned community and maintains an enforceable zon-

ing ordinance. Permits are required for all construction activities; signs, fences, demolition, decks, garages, sheds just to name a few. Also, the ordinance governs building sizes, number of accessory buildings allowed and commercial activities. Further, the ordinance specifies setback requirements which must be followed for placement of structures from property and lot lines. As a reminder, businesses that relocate must apply for a re-occupancy permit. Permits must be obtained prior to the start of any such activities.
