RECITALS:

Whereas, the Charter Township of Oscoda has determined that it is in the best interest of its residents to ensure funding by way of the attached millage for the continued operation of its Police Department, including the provision of the positions of a community service/code compliance officer and a detective;

Whereas, the Charter Township of Oscoda has determined that it is in the best interest of its residents to ensure funding by way of the attached millages for the continued operation of its Police Department, including the provision of the positions of a community service/code compliance officer and a detective;

Whereas, it is the intent of the Charter Township of Oscoda to provide its citizens the opportunity to propose the two (2) attached millages to its citizenry for its input by way of supporting and/or not supporting the request as contained therein;

Now therefore be it resolved, that Charter Township of Oscoda does hereby submit the two (2) attached millage requests to its citizenry and to cause the same to be placed upon the ballot for the election being held of the 6th day of August, 2024;

Ballot 1 (Police Operational Millage):

"In 2024, shall the Charter Township of Oscoda renew a previously voted millage of up to .80 mills (\$.80 per \$1,000 of taxable value) imposed under Article 9, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution for up to .80 mills to be levied for six (6) years, from 2024 through 2030 inclusive, commencing on the 1st day of November, 2024, for purposes of a police operating millage for salaries, benefits, equipment, training, and operations, subject to authorized disbursements mandated by law, raising an estimated \$307,561 in the first year the millage is levied."

Ballot two: (Police Community Service/Code Compliance Officer and Detective):

"In 2024, shall the Charter Township of Oscoda renew a previously voted millage of up to .70 mills (\$.70 per \$1,000 of taxable value) in the tax limitation imposed in Article 9, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution for up to .80 mills to be levied for six (6) years, from 2024 through 2030 inclusive, commencing on the 1st day of November, 2024, for purposes of adding a community service/code compliance and detective positions, subject to authorized disbursements mandated by law, raising an estimated \$269,115 in the first year the millage is levied.
