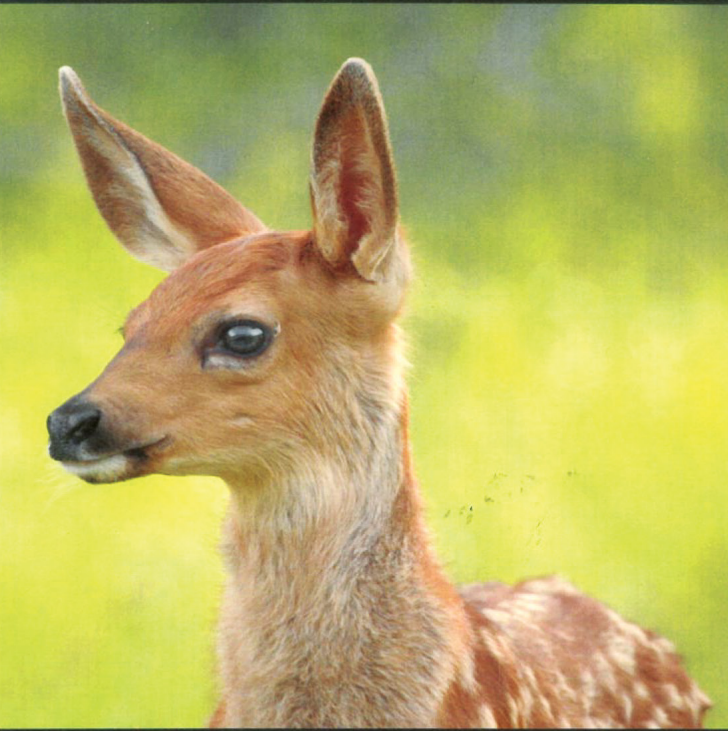


# PROTECT OUR NATIVE DEER



## BE ON THE ALERT AND PLEASE DRIVE SLOWLY

**DO NOT STARTLE:** Please do not attempt to feed or interact with deer as they can easily be startled, causing them to dart into traffic. It is illegal and dangerous to you and the animals.

Keep a safe distance while out with your dog, walking, or taking photographs.

**WATCH FOR GROUP BEHAVIOR:** Deer most often travel in groups. If one deer crosses the road, stop and watch for more to follow.



**BE EXTRA CAUTIOUS DRIVING, GO SLOW!:** During dawn and dusk hours, deer are active and difficult to see.

Fawns are easily startled and may suddenly run across the road to follow other deer.

Autumn is deer mating season and deer are more likely to move erratically. Spring is when fawns are born.
