INCIDENT: Attempted Armed Robbery

DATE: May 25th, 2024

TIME: Approximately 4:04 P.M.

LOCATION: Talcott Rd. at Chester Ave.

OFFENDER #1 DESCRIPTION: Male, unknown race, approximately 16-18 years old, Height 5'11", curly hair, wearing a brown t-shirt, surgical mask and gloves, riding a multi-colored bicycle. Offender #1 had a black, semi-automatic handgun in his waistband under his shirt.

OFFENDER #2 DESCRIPTION: Male, unknown race, 16-18 years old, Height 5'11", wearing a backpack.

The Park Ridge Police Department is investigating a report of an attempted armed robbery that occurred in the area of Talcott Rd and Chester Ave on Saturday, May 25th at approximately 4:04 P.M. Two male, juvenile victims stated that they had just left the 7-11 Store located at 555 Devon and were riding their bicycles on Talcott when they heard someone yelling from behind to stop. The juvenile victims then observed the two described male offenders ride up next to them on bicycles. Offender #1 then told the juvenile victims to give him all their belongings and proceeded to lift his shirt to display a dark colored semi-automatic handgun tucked in his waistband.

The juvenile victims stated that they did not give the offenders any of their belongings and that the offenders then rode off on their bicycles.
