

## **SERVICE COMMITTEE**

**JULY 27, 2020**

The meeting was called to order at 5:31 p.m. by Chairperson Jan Materni. Committee members present were Cory Kuhlman, Jan Materni, and Jonathan Smith. Also present were Bridgette Kabat, City Administrator, Laura Alkire, Law Director, and Rob Ross, Service Director.

### **APPOINTMENTS TO LITTER PREVENTION & RECYCLING BOARD**

Jonah Bruning and Xavier Rabatin were present to be considered as student representatives to the Litter Prevention and Recycling Board. Jonah said that he is a freshman at St. Francis and he is interested in keeping the community clean. Xavier is a senior at Perrysburg High School and he said that as part of his application for the Naval Academy, he wanted to find some way to serve the community. The Committee thanked both of them for volunteering to serve, and recommended 3-0 that they be appointed.

### **AGREEMENT WITH CAMPBELL MECHANICAL SERVICES FOR THE ACQUISITION OF AN AIR PURIFICATION SYSTEM FOR MUNICIPAL HVAC SYSTEMS**

Ms. Kabat called attention to the materials provided to the Committee regarding Global Plasma Solutions. Todd Kocsis and Kris Campbell of Campbell Mechanical Services were present to explain how the system works. Mr. Kocsis said that it puts negative and positive ions into the air to remove pollutants and allergens. Ms. Materni asked if it works with the heating and air conditioning. Mr. Kocsis said that it mounts on the HVAC equipment and as long as the blower is moving, it's working. Mr. Kuhlman asked if this will help with Covid-19. Mr. Kocsis said that it does; its effective rate is 99.4% in thirty minutes. Mr. Kuhlman asked if this purchase would qualify under the CARES Act. Ms. Alkire said that the \$166,000 cost would qualify for the CARES Act funds. She stated that language will be included in the legislation that the purchase is dependent upon the City receiving the CARES Act funds. There was a brief discussion about energy savings, but Ms. Kabat said that upgrading the controls is not a part of this. The Committee asked about other products that were looked at or if other quotes were received. Ms. Kabat said that they have a patent on this technology, and she is not sure of any other product available in this area. Mr. Kocsis explained the disadvantages of UV and ozone systems. Ms. Alkire said that we don't have to go out to bid because no other company offers this product. Mr. Smith asked what buildings will be included, and Ms. Kabat said every building that has people in it. The Committee agreed 3-0 to recommend approval of this purchase.

### **OTHER BUSINESS**

Mr. Smith said that the Wood County Transportation Improvement District has not met so he has no update.

Ms. Materni said that she saw employees from Public Service crack sealing, and she appreciates their hard work.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 6:04 p.m.
