### Entry-Level Law Enforcement Examination Now Open Apply Now For Plainfield Police Department

**PLAINFIELD, NJ** Effective January 3, 2022, the New Jersey Civil Service Commission (NJSCS) issued examination announcements for entry-level Law Enforcement Examination (LEE) titles. The NJSCS has restructured its application process. In previous years, applicants filled out one examination announcement and selected the jurisdictions and titles they were interested in. For this year's LEE, applicants must apply **specifically to the jurisdiction and title they desire.**
