Sixty (60) New Cases of COVID-19 Reported in Plainfield

August 18, 2022

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update, on Monday, August 15, 2022, there are **sixty (60) new cases of COVID-19**, with **thirty (30)** cases reported today. **** Please note that the State no longer requires the City to track or provide statistics for quarantined persons. As such this information will no longer be updated.**

Fortunately, there are no COVID related deaths to report. Please continue to exercise caution in crowded areas and wear masks whenever possible to reduce the chances of infection.
