Twenty-One (21) New Cases of COVID-19 Reported in Plainfield

November 14, 2022

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since our last update, on Thursday, November 10, 2022, there are **twenty-one (21) new cases of COVID-19**, with **seventeen (17)** cases reported today.

Fortunately, there are no COVID related deaths to report. Please continue to exercise caution in crowded areas and wear masks whenever possible to reduce the chances of infection.
