Forty-Eight (48) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Our last update was a week ago on October 14th. Since then, there have been forty-eight (48) new COVID-19 cases. In addition, forty-five (45) persons were quarantined. Furthermore, zero (0) COVID-19 related deaths were reported this week. The City of Plainfield urges residents to get vaccinated as we work together to fight the effects of the Delta Variant. Don't let misinformation or rumors about the COVID-19 vaccine prevent you from doing what's best for you and your family.

In addition, free COVID-19 testing at Kean University operates on Mondays from 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM and Thursdays from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Please visit UCNJ.org for more information. The test will also provide results for Influenza A and B (flu). **Insurance is not required.**
