Two Hundred and Thirty Nine (239) New Cases of COVID-19 Reported in Plainfield since the New Year

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Since January 1, 2022, there have been **two hundred and thirty nine (239) new cases of COVID-19**, with fifty nine (59) cases reported today. In addition, **one hundred and eight (108)** persons have been quarantined. Since the New Year there have been no deaths related to COVID-19. The dramatic rise in infection rates is concerning. Now more than ever we need to be vigilant and protect ourselves. The COVID-19 vaccine is our greatest weapon against this deadly virus. Get vaccinated, get your booster shots, and stay safe.

December 31 marked the last day of the “Plainfield Wins” Vaccine lottery. From July 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021, individuals who obtained the COVID-19 vaccine through the City of Plainfield, Union County, the Neighborhood Health Center, Plainfield CVS Pharmacy, Scott Drugs, or Rapp’s Pharmacy with any approved vaccine had the chance to win \$5,000. The final drawing for December vaccine winners will be held on **Friday, January 14th at 5:30 pm** via Facebook live.

In addition, free COVID-19 testing at Kean University operates on Mondays from 7:00 AM to 12 PM and Thursdays from 7 AM to 12 PM or 4 PM to 8 PM. Please visit UCNJ.org for more information. The test will also provide results for Influenza A and B (flu). **Insurance is not required.**

Plainfield, once we are vaccinated, we can begin to do more. We can recapture the life we knew if we all commit and do our part by getting vaccinated. It is vital to get tested if we experience any COVID-19 symptoms. We should continue to wear face masks, limit indoor gatherings, and practice social distancing while in public. Let’s remain vigilant.
