The City of Plainfield Teams Up with Union County, The State of New Jersey, and Vault Health Services to Offer Free Covid-19 Testing at Plainfield Performing Arts Center

Plainfield, New Jersey: The City of Plainfield is partnering with Union County, the State of New Jersey, and Vault Health Services to provide free public Covid-19 testing in Plainfield. Starting Tuesday, January 18, 2022, rapid and PCR testing will be offered at the Plainfield Performing Arts Center (P-PAC), 724 Park Avenue, Plainfield. For the next eight weeks, the P-PAC Covid Testing Clinic will open five days a week, Tuesday-Friday 12:00 pm-7:45 pm and Saturday 9:00 am-2:45 pm. The P-PAC Testing Clinic is open to all, and ID is required. Persons needing testing are encouraged to pre-register online at [SWAB.VLT.CO](https://www.swab.vlt.co) for rapid testing and [COVID.VLT.CO](https://www.covid.vlt.co) for PCR.

Please bring a smartphone or other internet-enabled device with a web browser to complete the registration upon arrival at the P-PAC. Clinic staff will be available to assist people with this registration. Masks are required at P-PAC for all employees and visitors regardless of vaccination status. Entrance to Municipal Parking is available on East 7th Street. For inquiries and concerns regarding your PCR results, please call (212) 880-5494.

Mapp. “This testing site is one more resource for our residents and will augment the testing already taking place in various other parts of the city and alleviate the long lines and long wait times for results.
