Sixty-four (64) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

November 4, 2021

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Our last update was on October 22nd. Since then, there have been sixty-four (64) new COVID-19 cases. In addition, fifty-eight (58) persons were quarantined. Unfortunately, on October 26th, one (1) COVID-19 related death was reported.

VACCINE UPDATE – For the month of September, a total of **316 individuals** received the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, and **157 individuals** received the second dose. Additionally, since the implementation of the Plainfield Wins Campaign in July, **2,300 individuals** have been vaccinated.

Get vaccinated through the City of Plainfield, Union County, the Neighborhood Health Center, Plainfield CVS Pharmacy, Scott Drugs, or Rapp's Pharmacy with any approved vaccine for your chance to win \$5,000. Plainfield residents must be 18 years or older to qualify, and proof of residency must be shown at the time of vaccination.

Reminder – The City of Plainfield is hosting a series of Pop up Vaccination Clinics every Wednesday from 4 PM – 7 PM at the Black Lives Matter Plaza in front of City Hall. Come by and enjoy some ice cream while you take this vital step in the fight against COVID-19. A list of additional locations can be found on the city's [website](#).

In addition, free COVID-19 testing at Kean University operates on Mondays from 7:00 AM to 12 PM and Thursdays from 7 AM to 12 PM or 4 pm to 8 pm. Please visit UCNJ.org for more information. The test will also provide results for Influenza A and B (flu). **Insurance is not required.**

Plainfield, once we are vaccinated, we can begin to do more. We can be with each other and part take of much more. We can recapture the life we knew if we all commit and do our part by getting vaccinated. It is vital to get tested if we experience any COVID-19 symptoms. We should continue to wear face masks, limit indoor gatherings, and practice social distancing while in public. Let's remain vigilant.
