Correction to Dec. 6th Release

Two hundred and Thirty-Four (234) New Cases of COVID-19 Reported in Plainfield Over the Last Month

December 7, 2021

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Our last update was on November 4. Since then, there have been two hundred and thirty-four (234) new COVID-19 cases. **Eighty-one (81) were reported between Thursday, December 2nd to Monday, December 6th.** In addition, one hundred and eighty-four (184) persons were quarantined. Thankfully, there have been no COVID-19 related deaths since October 26. As we prepare for the Holidays and the New Year, Plainfield, please take caution when venturing out to do your holiday shopping and gatherings. Remember, a new variant of the COVID-19 virus (Omicron) has appeared.

As of December 6, roughly 74% of Plainfield's population, 38,657 out of 51,920 residents recorded in the 2020 census, have been vaccinated.

In October, Plainfield Wins campaign vaccinated a total of **209 individuals** with the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, and **196 individuals** with the second dose. **November winners will be drawn on December 10.**

Get vaccinated through the City of Plainfield, Union County, the Neighborhood Health Center, Plainfield CVS Pharmacy, Scott Drugs, or Rapp's Pharmacy with any approved vaccine for your chance to win \$5,000. Plainfield residents must be 18 years or older to qualify, and proof of residency must be shown at the time of vaccination.

In addition, free COVID-19 testing at Kean University operates on Mondays from 7:00 AM to 12 PM and Thursdays from 7 AM to 12 PM or 4 PM to 8 PM. Please visit UCNJ.org for more information. The test will also provide results for Influenza A and B (flu). **Insurance is not required.**

Plainfield, once we are vaccinated, we can begin to do more. We can recapture the life we knew if we all commit and do our part by getting vaccinated. It is vital to get tested if we experience any COVID-19 symptoms. We should continue to wear face masks, limit indoor gatherings, and practice social distancing while in public. Let's remain vigilant.
