Sixty-Four (64) New Cases of COVID-19 in Plainfield

September 23, 2021

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

Our last update was on Wednesday, September 15. Since then, there are sixty-four (64) new COVID-19 cases. In addition, forty-two (42) persons were quarantined. Fortunately, no deaths related to COVID-19 have been reported since September 1st. Plainfield, keep up the good work. Spread the word and motivate more people to get vaccinated.

In addition, free COVID-19 testing at Kean University operates on Mondays from 8:00 AM to 11:30 AM and Thursdays from 8:30 AM to 11:30 AM. Please visit UCNJ.org for more information. The test will also provide results for Influenza A and B (flu). **Insurance is not required.**

The vaccine offers a promise of returning to normalcy. Plainfield, once we are vaccinated, we can begin to do more, be with each other, share hugs and closeness once again. We can recapture the life we knew if we all commit and do our part by getting vaccinated. It is vital to get tested if we experience any COVID-19 symptoms. We should continue to wear face masks, limit indoor gatherings, and practice social distancing while in public. Let's remain vigilant.
