

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF PLAINFIELD SOLID WASTE UTILITY IN THE COUNTY OF UNION STATE OF NEW JERSEY REQUESTS THE APPROVAL OF ADJUSTMENTS TO THE UTILITY'S TRANSFER STATION BULKY WASTE (TYPE 13), CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE, (13C), VEGETATIVE WASTE (23), AND ROLL-OFF CONTAINER RENTAL AND DISPOSAL RATES FOR NON-RESIDENTS, COMMERCIAL, BUSINESS, NEIGHBORING/OUTSIDE MUNICIPALITIES

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Plainfield, in the County of Union, State of New Jersey (the "City"), created the Plainfield Municipal Utilities Authority (the "Authority") via an Ordinance duly adopted on September 18, 1995, in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 183 of the Laws of New Jersey of 1957, and acts amendatory thereof or supplemental thereto; and

WHEREAS, the Authority was previously dissolved to better provide to the residents of the City and the users of the solid waste and sewer facilities by creating a Solid Waste and Sewer Utility for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Utility seeks to amend its rates in order to meet the Utility's budget for such solid waste services; and

WHEREAS, such adjustments shall be for non-residents, commercial, business and neighboring/outside municipalities seeking these paramount services; and

WHEREAS, the adoption and implementation of the proposed adjustments to the Bulky Waste including mattresses (13), Construction and Demolition Waste (13c), Vegetative Waste (23) and the Roll-Off Container Rental and Disposal Rates is necessary for the continued efficient operation of the Solid Waste Utility; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of Plainfield, in the County of Union, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The City Council hereby approves and adopts the Utility Transfer Station proposal adjustments to the Bulky Waste Rate including mattresses (type 13), the Construction and Demolition Waste Rate (13c), from \$120.00 per ton to \$135.00 per ton with a scale house minimum of \$135.00 per ton per vehicles. Vegetative Waste Rate (23), from \$70.00 per ton to \$90.00 per ton for waste disposed of at the Utility Transfer Station from non-residents, commercial, businesses and neighboring/outside municipalities
2. The Roll-Off Container Rental and Disposal rates from \$305.00 with a one (1) ton minimum for 10, 20 or 30 cubic yard containers, to the new rate of \$550.00 with a two (2) ton maximum (10 cu.yd container); \$650.00 (3) ton maximum (20 cu. yd container) and \$750.00 (4) ton maximum (30 cu.yd container). All maximum tonnage overage will be charged at \$135 per ton.

BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, by the Council of the city of Plainfield, that: This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication according to the law
