

**Town of Plainfield
Notice of Public Hearing
August 31, 2000**

The Board of Selectmen of the Town of Plainfield, Connecticut, will hold a public hearing at the Plainfield Town Hall, 8 Community Avenue, Plainfield, Connecticut, on Thursday, August 31, 2000 at 7:00 p.m. to consider a proposed ordinance as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 107

AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING DOG EXCREMENTS

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to cause or permit a dog under his/her ownership or control to be on any property, public or private, not owned by such person, unless such person shall have in his/her possession a device for the removal of any excrement which might be deposited by such dog. Any person who owns or controls a dog which deposits excrement upon any property, public or private, shall promptly remove such excrement to a proper receptacle located on property owned or possessed by such person. This provision shall not apply to blind or physically handicapped persons while walking their guide dog.

SECTION 2: Any person violating this ordinance shall be fined \$25.00, which amount shall be paid to the Plainfield Town Treasurer within ten days of each offense. Fines not paid in a timely manner shall be doubled.
