

**56. AT A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING HELD ON WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 8, 1975,
AT THE PLAINFIELD TOWN HALL, AT 7:30 P.M.,
THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE WAS ADOPTED:
ORDINANCE**

Amend Ordinance No. 16 of The Town of Plainfield, entitled, "Ordinance Concerning Establishment of Nursing And Health Services."

"Said Nursing and Health Service shall be governed by a Board of Directors as appointed by the Board of Selectmen. The Board of Directors shall be comprised of at least nine (9) and not more than 15 citizens of the Town of Plainfield and each member of the Board of Directors shall be appointed for a term of two years. The Board of Directors are hereby charged with the duty of governing the Nursing and Health Service on a day to day basis subject to the advice and consent of a majority of the Board of Selectmen."

This Amendment to the Ordinance shall become effective 15 days after publication in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes.
