

60. **AT A SPECIAL TOWN MEETING HELD ON OCTOBER 17, 1977,
AT THE PLAINFIELD TOWN HALL, AT 7:30 P.M.,
THE FOLLOWING AMENDMENT TO ORDINANCE NO. 24,
REGULATING USE OF PUBLIC SEWERS WAS ADOPTED:
ORDINANCE**

To change Article III, Section II, of the Town of Plainfield Sewer Ordinance to read as follows:

SECTION II. Building sewers which must be located within 25 to 75 feet from a private well shall be either cast iron pipe with leaded joints, asbestos cement pipe with standard O-ring gaskets, clay pipe with type III joint or type PSM poly (vinyl chloride) (PVC) sewer pipe and fittings with solvent cement joints or elastomeric gasket joints in conformance with ASTM standard D-3034.74 or latest edition. In any case, the pipe shall be tested to assure a leakage not to exceed 50 gallons, per mile, per inch, per day, tested at a minimum hydraulic head of at least 2 feet.

In accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes this Ordinance shall take effect fifteen (15) days after publication.
