

**ORDINANCE NO. 87**

**AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING**

**HEALTH CARE SERVICES**

Be it Ordained By The Town Meeting of The Town of Plainfield:

Sec. 1. Ordinance No. 16 entitled "Ordinance Concerning Establishment of Nursing and Health Services", and Ordinance No. 56 amending said Ordinance No. 16, are hereby repealed.

Sec. 2 The Board of Selectmen of The Town of Plainfield be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, with any health care institution licensed by the State of Connecticut Department of Health Services, or its successor, for the purpose of providing to residents of the Town of Plainfield nursing services, homemaker - home health aide, physical therapy, speech therapy, occupational therapy, medical social services, health clinics, including blood pressure checks as deemed necessary, provided, that such services shall be substantially equivalent to the services theretofore provided by the Plainfield Nursing and Health Service.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall become effective fifteen (15) days after publication in accordance with the Charter of the Town of Plainfield.
