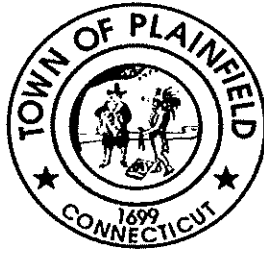

Consider and act on Tentative Agreement between the Town of Plainfield and United Public Service Employees Union (UPSEU), Local 1303-358 Plainfield Dispatchers for a Collective Bargaining agreement covering the period of July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2027. Action by the Board of Selectman of the Town of Plainfield pursuant to the Connecticut General Statutes Sec. 7-474(b).
6. Discuss and bypass of the Procurement policy for approved Community Center Upgrades and Town Pool as the contractor is on the state bid list.
7. Discuss and act on expenditure of ARPA funds for purchase of a 6,000 gallon fuel tank for the placement at the highway department.
