**TOWN OF PLAINFIELD  
Public Hearing Minutes  
July 28, 2021**

Kevin Cunningham called the public hearing to order at 6:30 pm at the Plainfield Town Hall.

Members present were Kevin Cunningham and Art Gagne. Cathy Tendrich was absent.

After a review of the proposed 8 Charter changes were presented to the town attorney, it was determined that only one proposed change was not relevant at this time (Section 3-4).

SECTION 2-3a Shall the date of the annual town meeting be changed to take place after the audit report is finished, but no later than the end February?

SECTION 2-4b Shall the percentage of eligible electors casting ballots at a Referendum be changed from 25% to 10%?

SECTION 2-4d The Capital Budget shall be provided as a question to approve or reject as part of the Annual Town Budget Referendum or Town Budget meeting. Only if rejected shall it be subject to revision and subsequent balloting procedures as stated in subsection b of this section?

SECTION 2-5b Shall the dollar amount of non-budgeted appropriations be updated from \$10,000 to \$50,000 minimum, and from \$50,000 to \$100,000 maximum, before a town meeting is needed?

SECTION 2-5d Shall the minimum dollar amount for shared grants be increased from \$10,000 to \$50,000 before a town meeting is needed?

SECTION 3-4 Shall changes to the voting and polling places for each vote be determined, upon recommendation of the registrars, by the Board of Selectmen?

SECTION 4-1b Shall the Board of Finance increase from 6 regular members to 7?

SECTION 9-2d Shall the appointment to a position of financial gain be modified to include steps, in-laws, and domestic partners?

There was not any input or comments for the proposed changes from the public.

*Art Gagne motioned to adjourn at 6:33 pm, Frank Mills seconded. All in favor, motion passed.*
