Two women have been charged with a shooting on July 8th, in Northmoor, Missouri. Renyshia Handson and Aaliyah Kidd were charged with separate offenses related to the incident.

On July 8, 2023, Platte County deputies and officers of the Riverside Police Department responded to reports of a shooting at a restaurant in Northmoor.

The shooting allegedly occurred after an argument over a food order at the restaurant. Witnesses reported seeing and hearing an altercation between restaurant employees and Kidd. Witnesses also reported seeing Handson produce a handgun and point it at the back of the head of one person.

Witnesses also reported that Handson fired the gun, striking a second victim in the left foot.

Prosecuting Attorney Eric Zahnd said, "We are fortunate no one lost their life simply because someone pulled out a gun over a food order. Thanks to an excellent work of the Platte County Sheriff's Office and the Riverside Police Department, these defendants were immediately apprehended and charged."

Sheriff Mark Owen stated, "Once again, the cooperation between law enforcement agencies and the willingness of witnesses to come forward has allowed charges to be brought against these defendants."

Handson has been charged with Unlawful Use of a Weapon and is being held on a cash-only bond of \$100,000. Kidd has been charged with Assault 3rd Degree with a cash-only bond of \$5,000. Both defendants are currently being held in the Platte County Detention Center.

Zahnd said the investigation into the incident is still ongoing and additional charges could be filed.

The charges against Kidd and Handson are merely allegations, and they are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.
