**Two women have been charged with a shooting on July 8<sup>th</sup>, in Northmoor, Missouri. Renyshia Handson and Aaliyah Kidd were charged with separate offenses related to the incident.**

**On July 8, 2023, Platte County deputies and officers of the Riverside Police Department responded to reports of a shooting at a restaurant in Northmoor.**

**The shooting allegedly occurred after an argument over a food order at the restaurant. Witnesses reported seeing and hearing an altercation between restaurant employees and Kidd. Witnesses also reported seeing Handson produce a handgun and point it at the back of the head of one person.**

**Witnesses also reported that Handson fired the gun, striking a second victim in the left foot.**

**Prosecuting Attorney Eric Zahnd said, "We are fortunate no one lost their life simply because someone pulled out a gun over a food order. Thanks to an excellent work of the Platte County Sheriff's Office and the Riverside Police Department, these defendants were immediately apprehended and charged."**

**Sheriff Mark Owen stated, "Once again, the cooperation between law enforcement agencies and the willingness of witnesses to come forward has allowed charges to be brought against these defendants."**

**Handson has been charged with Unlawful Use of a Weapon and is being held on a cash-only bond of \$100,000. Kidd has been charged with Assault 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree with a cash-only bond of \$5,000. Both defendants are currently being held in the Platte County Detention Center.**

**Zahnd said the investigation into the incident is still ongoing and additional charges could be filed.**

**The charges against Kidd and Handson are merely allegations, and they are presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty.**
