Bidders may deliver Bids to the drop-box located at the front of the building located on 106 Brown Avenue, Prospect Park New Jersey up until **Thursday May 30th, 2024 at 12:00 P.M.** Bidders are reminded that proposals shall be enclosed in a sealed opaque envelope and the outside of the envelope shall bear the name, address and email address of the bidder as well as the indication, "**HOFSTRA PARK PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS**". It is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that the bid is received on time. Neither the Borough, nor the Engineer will assume any responsibility for bids mis-mailed, misdelivered, or misdirected.

A certified check or bank draft, payable to the order of Borough of Prospect Park, or negotiable U. S. Government Bonds (at par value), or a satisfactory Bid Bond executed by the Bidder and an acceptable surety, in an amount of ten (10%) percent of the total of the Total Bid not to exceed \$20,000 shall be submitted with each bid.

Bids shall include a Consent of Surety obligating the issuing surety to provide the bidder, if awarded a contract for the Project, with performance and payment bonds as required by the Project Specifications.

The Borough of Prospect Park reserves the right to waive any informality in and to accept or reject any and all bids. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) days.

Bidders must submit with their bids the non-collusion affidavit contained in the contract documents.

The successful bidder will be required to comply with all provisions of prevailing wage rates as determined by the New Jersey Department of Labor.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31, et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27, regarding Affirmative Action and Executive Order 11246 regarding Equal Opportunity, and with all provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et. seq. and all rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, the provisions of which are incorporated herein by reference.

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 34:11-56.50 et seq., Bidders and their subcontractors are required to be registered with the New Jersey Department of Labor and to possess a current certificate from said Department indicating compliance at the time of Bidding.

Please be advised that State funds through the Green Acres Program are being utilized in this project. Bidders and the successful contractor will be required to comply with all Rules and Regulations relating to Green Acres Funding. Under N.J.A.C. 7:1-5, vendors currently suspended, debarred, or disqualified are excluded from participation in this project.

New Jersey Business Registration Requirements: N.J.S.A. 40A:11-23.2 requires all contractors and subcontractors with public contracting agencies to provide proof of registration with the Department of Treasury, Division of Revenue. The contractor shall provide written notice to its subcontractors of the responsibility to submit proof of business registration to the contractor. The requirement of proof of business registration extends down through all levels (tiers) of the project. Before final payment on the contract is made by the contracting agency, the contractor shall submit an accurate list and the proof of business registration of each subcontractor or supplier used in the fulfillment of the contract or shall attest that no subcontractors were used. For the term of the contract, the contractor and each of its affiliates and a subcontractor and each of its affiliates [N.J.S.A. 52:32-44(g) (3)] shall collect and remit to the Director, New Jersey Division of Taxation, the use tax due pursuant to the Sales and Use Tax Act on all sales of tangible personal property delivered into this State, regardless of whether the tangible personal property is intended for a contract with a contracting agency.

The successful bidder will be required to break ground on or before June 30, 2024, granted that the governing body awards the contract before this date.

The owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding.

No vendor or listed subcontractor who is listed on the State Treasurer's or the Federal Government's List of Debarred, Suspended or Disqualified Vendors shall be eligible to submit a bid or proposal.
