Personnel Policy Discussion

The Administration would like to move forward with the approval of the City of Randleman's Personnel Policy. Alderwoman Bryant stated that she would like to revisit the policy and have the changes identified.

Retiree Health Insurance Benefits

Guidelines were presented and "in good standing" was discussed. Chief Leonard (Steve) has concerns with the policy change regarding the adverse impact this could have on the recruitment of new officers. Alderwoman Bryant would like to discuss one-on-one with Chief Leonard before accepting the revisions.

<u>Condemnations – Stevenson and Penny Street</u>
