### **Public Comment**

She did acknowledge that the Police patrol the area but this does not seem to deter any of the activities. She suggested that a gate be installed.

**Mr. John Savachak** a resident of 114 Presnell Street added his concerns about the activities at the River Park Trail. He also cited the speed limit not being observed, the blind curve and limited site distance. He also expressed his concerns regarding the children that live on this street.

**Mr. David Moorehouse** resides at 210 Commonwealth Street and spoke to the Board at the last meeting. He stated that he would like to clarify his remarks. It was his intention to ask Board members what "In God We Trust" means to each member of the Board.

He was advised by Attorney Wilhoit that the Public Comment Session was to allow citizens to address the Board as an entity and should not expect comments from the Board.

However, Alderwoman Bryant, Alderman Betts and Alderman Fogleman provided information as to how we arrived with the "In God We Trust" National Motto on display.
