On February 21, 2020, at around 11:48 p.m., Randleman Police responded to a domestic dispute and the discharging of a firearm at 328 E. Naomi Street, Randleman.

When officers arrived they made entry into the residence and secured the scene. Alyssa Michelle Honeycutt, 25, of 328 E. Naomi Street, Randleman, told officers that earlier she had left the house with a friend and had stayed gone longer than expected. Honeycutt told officers that when she and her friend returned to the residence her boyfriend, Rodavis Raysean Stewart, 23, of 328 E. Naomi Street, Randleman, came out of the residence angry, pointed a gun at her and forced her to go in the house to her bedroom. The friend that Honeycutt had been with left the residence to call 9-1-1.

Honeycutt told officers that once she and Stewart entered the bedroom, Stewart shut the door, pointed the gun to the left of her and fired the gun.

Officers recovered a firearm, empty shell casing and a projectile from the bedroom.

Stewart was arrested and charged with felony second degree kidnapping, felony discharge of a firearm within a residence with the intent to incite fear, felony possession of a firearm by felon, assault by pointing a gun, assault on a female and discharge a firearm inside city limits.

Stewart was placed in the Randolph County Jail under a \$ 100,000 secured bond.
