On April 17th around 3:30 p.m., Randleman Police observed a burgundy Hyundai Sonata, with a female in the front passenger seat, in the driveway of 107 S. Coble Street. The officer recognized the vehicle, which had been stolen on March 24th from the Deep River Nature Trail on Presnell Street, Randleman.

Officers approached the residence and located Janelle Ann Gilmer, 52, unknown address, in the vehicle and Stephen Kyle Barzdins, 38, of 107 S. Coble Street, Randleman, exiting the residence. Both Barzdins and Gilmer were wanted by Randleman police for a crime spree that began in late February and came to an end on April 17th.

Barzdins was arrested and charged with 6 counts obtaining property by false pretense, 11 counts misdemeanor larceny, 11 counts possession of stolen goods, 4 counts possession of a firearm by felon, 4 counts larceny of a firearm, 4 counts possession of a stolen firearm, 2 counts break and enter a motor vehicle, felony larceny, possession of methamphetamine, breaking into a coin operated machine, larceny of a motor vehicle, possession of a stolen motor vehicle, forgery of an instrument, uttering a forged instrument and probation violation. Barzdins was placed in the Randolph County Jail under a \$205,000 secured bond.

Gilmer was arrested and charged with 2 counts break and enter a motor vehicle, 3 counts misdemeanor larceny, 3 counts possession of stolen goods, possession of methamphetamine, possess drug paraphernalia. Gilmer was placed in the Randolph County Jail under a \$15,000 secured bond.
