### **Press Release**

At 8:16 p.m. Tuesday, Randleman Police responded to the parking lot at 630 W. Academy Street to a domestic dispute with one person being shot.

Officers found the victim, Holly Renee Gable, 38, of Randleman, inside Sopranos Italian Restaurant located at 638 W. Academy Street where she had ran to for help. Gable had a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the head.

Gable told officers that her ex-boyfriend, William Charles Lounsbury Jr, 45, of Randleman, picked her up at a friend's house in Randleman around 7:30 p.m. Lounsbury told Gable he did not have any money and had not eaten in two days. Lounsbury drove Gable to McDonald's in Randleman where Gable went inside the restaurant to get food for Lounsbury. Lounsbury then drove to the southwest corner of the parking lot at 630 W. Academy Street in Randleman.

Lounsbury demanded Gable to give her cell phone to him, Gable refused. Lounsbury then put a handgun against Gable's side and told her he would beat her until she gave him the phone. Gable told officers she turned in an attempt to exit the vehicle, felt the handgun against her head and heard a gunshot.

Gable was able to exit the vehicle and ran to Sopranos Italian Restaurant for help. Gable was taken to a local hospital where she was treated and released for a non-life threatening gunshot wound to the head.

Lounsbury fled the scene in a white 2020 Ford Fusion with a thirty-day paper tag before officers arrived.

Charges against Lounsbury are, assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill, attempted robbery with a dangerous weapon, discharge a firearm within enclosure to incite fear, assault by pointing a gun, assault on a female and communicating threats.
