2. Determine that the wall/roof will support the ladder				
3. Checks for overhead obstruction before raising				
4. Extension ladder is raised a minimum of 5 rungs above roof edge (Ensure that the locks, pawls or dogs are locked and halyard is tied)				
5. Ensures ladders are heeled or secured at all times while on ladders				
6. Extends roof hooks and raises roof ladder to rest against extension ladder – CRITICAL				
7. Climbs extension ladder until reaching the midpoint of the roof ladder that is positioned next to you; places roof ladder on shoulder and climbs to roof edge				
8. Climbs to proper position and performs a leg lock or secures to ladder with ladder belt; takes roof ladder off shoulder and slides ladder on roof until hooks go over ridge and are secure – CRITICAL				
9. Ladder is stable and under control at all times

2. Climbs ladder, maintaining 3 points of contact, carrying a hose rope tool or webbing to secure to the ladder				
3. Safely advance charged hose line up the ladder				
4. Climbs to proper position and performs a leg lock or secures to ladder with ladder belt – CRITICAL				
5. Places nozzle over the rung approximately 12” and secures hose to the ladder using hose rope tool or webbing				
6. Opens then closes nozzle slowly to prevent water hammer - CRITICAL
