COVID-19 Update

August 26, 2021

Total Tested RCCHC: 2,188 (+14)

Total Positive Tests: 146 (+2)/2 Active, 141 Recovered, 3 Death

Active Monitoring: 15 (2 positives/13 Close Contacts)

The Red Cliff Community Health Center reports 2 new cases of Covid-19 today. NOTE** There was one (1) additional positive test for an individual residing outside the Red Cliff jurisdiction.



COVID-19 spreads mainly from person-to-person through respiratory droplets and aerosols. If you find out that you've been in close contact with someone with COVID-19, you may be at risk of infection. Learn more about what it means to be a close contact and what you should do once it's been determined that you've been exposed to COVID-19.

What is a "close contact"? You are considered a close contact if any of the following situations happened while you spent time with a person with COVID-19, even if they didn't have symptoms:

- You were within 6 feet of a person who had COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.
- You had direct exposure to respiratory secretions (for example, being coughed or sneezed on, sharing a
 drinking glass, utensils, towels or other personal items).
- You had direct physical contact with the person (for example, a hug, kiss, or handshake).
- You cared or care for a person who has COVID-19.
- You lived or live with a person who has COVID-19.
- You stayed overnight with them for at least one night in the same household.
