COVID-19 Update

October 6, 2021

Total Tested RCCHC: 2,562 (+24)

Total Positive Tests: 174 (+1)/6 Active, 165 Recovered, 3 Death

Quarantine: 26

Active Monitoring: 26 (6 positives/20 Close Contacts)

The Red Cliff Community Health Center reports one (1) new case of Covid-19 today. There were three additional positive cases, but they live outside Red Cliff jurisdiction.

COVID 19 BREAKTHROUGH INFECTIONS –

- Vaccine breakthrough infections are expected. COVID-19 vaccines are effective at preventing most infections. However, like other vaccines, they are not 100% effective.
- Fully vaccinated people with a vaccine breakthrough infection are less likely to develop serious illness than those who are unvaccinated and get COVID-19.
- Even when fully vaccinated people develop symptoms, they tend to be less severe than in unvaccinated people. This means they are less likely to be hospitalized or die than unvaccinated people.
- People who get vaccine breakthrough infections can be contagious.

For now, if you've been fully vaccinated:

- You will still need to follow guidance at your workplace and local businesses.
- You should still watch out for symptoms of COVID-19, especially if you've been around someone who is sick. If you have symptoms of COVID-19, you should get tested and stay home and away from others. If your test is positive, isolate at home for 10 days.
- People who have a condition or are taking medications that weaken the immune system, should continue to take all precautions recommended for unvaccinated people until advised otherwise by their provider.
