

# COVID-19 Situation Summary for Red Cliff, WI

August 12, 2020

## Local Update

There are 8 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Bayfield County since the last Situation Summary. This brings the total number of cases to 29. Eight (8) are actively under surveillance. Twenty (20) have recovered.

There is one reported death related to COVID-19 in Bayfield County. According to the WI Dept of Health website, three (3) initial cases were confirmed in March with a lull in confirmed infections through June 2020. With the re-opening of all businesses and increased travel in June, Bayfield county has noted an uptick in confirmed infection. All 26 new cases have been confirmed in the months of July and August.

Surrounding counties with confirmed cases:

- Ashland County (Ashland, WI): 26 confirmed cases, 1 confirmed death. There have been 6 new cases since the last Situation Summary 1 week ago.
- Douglas County (Superior, WI): 191 confirmed cases, no deaths. There have been 52 new cases since the last Situation Summary 1 week ago.
- St. Louis County (Duluth, MN): 573 confirmed cases, 19 deaths.

## National Update

The total confirmed cases in Wisconsin continues to climb steadily. Confirmed cases stand at 61,785 as of August 11, 2020, of which there are 1,006 deaths. This represents a 1.6% death rate from confirmed cases.

Of the confirmed 61,785 cases, 51,456 individuals are considered recovered from COVID-19, and 9,305 individuals are actively being followed currently.
