Local Update

There are **4 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Bayfield County** since the last Situation Summary.

- Total confirmed cases: 46
- Active cases: 7
- Recovered cases: 38
- Deaths: 1
- Currently monitoring: 59 individuals

There were three (3) initial COVID-19 cases confirmed in March. All 43 additional cases have been confirmed in the months of July and August.

Surrounding counties with confirmed cases:

- **Ashland County (Ashland, WI):** 36 confirmed cases, 1 death; 5 new cases since the last Situation Summary 1 week ago.
 - **Douglas County (Superior, WI):** 257 confirmed cases, no deaths; 16 new cases since the last Situation Summary 1 week ago.
 - **St. Louis County (Duluth, MN):** 902 confirmed cases, 23 deaths; 125 new cases since the last Situation Summary 1 week ago.

National Update

Wisconsin has started to flatten the curve after a steady upward trend of positive cases. As of Sept 1, 2020:

- Total confirmed: 76,584
- Recovered: 67,902
- Deaths: 1,130
- Active cases: 7,534
- Hospitalizations: 5,878

The United States surpassed 6 million cases of COVID-19 as of this past weekend.

Total Cases in the United States:	6,004,443
Deaths:	183,050

Global Update

COVID-19 infections globally surpassed **24 million cases** with over **800,000 deaths** as of September 1, 2020. Overall, there is a trend of increased cases but decreased deaths globally as compared to the previous week. The United States continues to account for about one-quarter of all infections and roughly 20% of all deaths globally.
