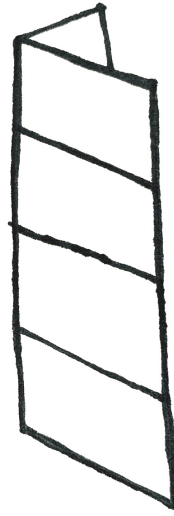

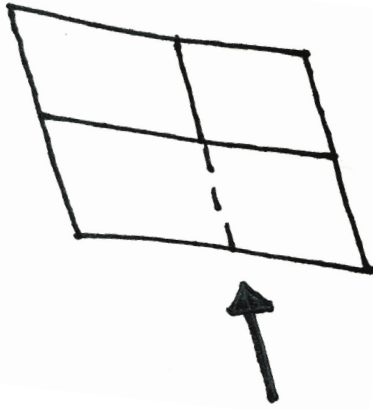
Silver maples

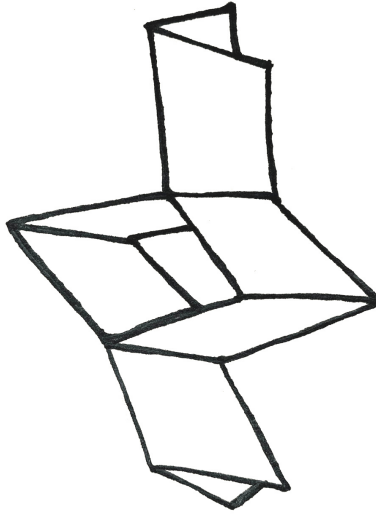
# Making the Booklet



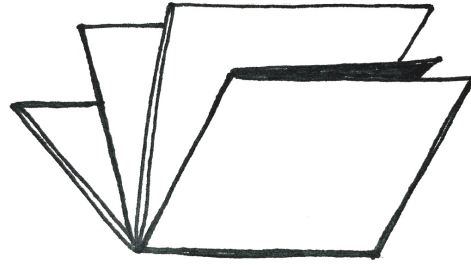
1.) Fold paper along all of the black lines to form creases.



2.) Fold in half the short way (hamburger-fold) and cut along the dotted line. Stop cutting when you reach the solid line.



3.) Fold in half the long way (hotdog-fold). Push to open up the middle and continue until it collapses to form pages.



4.) Fold the pages so that the cover is on the front and all the other pages form the booklet.
