CHAPTER 54 – ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

54.1 **SECTION 1: FINDINGS, PURPOSE AND INTENT**

54.1.1 For the benefit of the public health, safety and welfare of the tribal membership and Red Cliff community, the Tribe hereby enacts uniform regulations governing the sale of alcoholic beverages within the Reservation.

54.2 **SECTION 2: DEFINITIONS**

54.2.1 “Alcoholic beverages” means any beverage containing alcohol.

54.2.2 “Retail seller” means any seller licensed by the Tribe to sell alcoholic beverages.

54.3 **SECTION 3: SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES: HOURS**

It is unlawful to sell alcoholic beverages within the reservation except pursuant to a license issued by the Tribe. No retail seller shall sell alcoholic beverages for off premises consumption between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m.

54.4 **SECTION 4: PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION**

Violations of sec. 54.3 shall result in a civil forfeiture of not less than \$500 nor more than \$5,000. Each sale of alcohol shall constitute a separate violation. Repeated violations of sec. 54.3 shall constitute grounds for denial or revocation of a retail seller’s business permit under RCCL Chapter 16.
