## **Red Cliff Takes More Steps Towards Increasing Affordable Housing Options**

### **Red Cliff Receives USDA Grant Award**

The Red Cliff Band has been awarded a \$50K U.S. Department of Agriculture Rural Wisconsin Home Repair Grant that will assist four low and very-low income households within the reservation boundaries renovate their homes.

The USDA grant will be leveraged with \$30K of funds through the Native American Home Rehabilitation Program Grant and another \$53K through the Red Cliff Chippewa Housing Authority Indian Housing Block Grant.

*"Our private home rehabilitation program is an extension of our growing Native American Homeownership initiative," said Cheryl Cloud, Red Cliff Chippewa Housing Authority Executive Director. "Maintenance and upkeep of a home can be costly. Accessing grant funds to help improve housing quality standards for Red Cliff Tribal homeowners expresses our support and commitment to a well-rounded program. We don't just want to help you buy a home, we want to help you keep it livable and comfortable."*

### **Red Cliff Selected to Participate in WHEDA's Rural Affordable Housing Initiative Program**

WHEDA's rural affordable workforce housing initiative represents an effort to address housing shortage challenges in rural Wisconsin. The initiative includes a housing pilot program that will establish an adaptive framework to identify needs, evaluate choices and implement solutions.

Red Cliff, along with other Chequamegon Bay municipalities, represents one of three communities selected to participate in the rural affordable workforce housing pilot. The pilot involves three phases: research and community engagement, idea generation, and implementation. The process will be staggered among the communities, with completion including implementation and measurement for all communities by the fall of 2022.

*"This pilot program will allow Red Cliff to be a part of designing an alternative affordable housing option which addresses specific challenges faced by seasonal employees in maintaining year-long housing stability in traditional housing models," said Cloud. "The outcome is to come away with a design that can be implemented both regionally, and individually in each community. Having additional affordable housing options provides us with more tools and solutions."*

If you plan to vote in person, know your polling place. Find state-specific voter info at [NativeVote.org](https://NativeVote.org).

3 Stay informed about the latest election information by checking your latest state laws and rules through your state's election office website

4 Research the candidates and initiatives before voting

4 Vote early if voting by mail to avoid USPS mail delays or use a voter drop box

5 Organize transportation to polling places

6 On Election Day, bring a state-approved ID card and follow CDC and tribal-approved COVID-19 protocols

### October is Depression Awareness Month!



**October is also Bullying Prevention Month and October 10th is World Mental Health Day!**

It is estimated that one in 15 adults (6.7%) will experience depression in any given year and one in six people (16.6%) will suffer from depression at some point in their lifetime. As you can see, depression is more common than most people think. Like other diseases, people suffer depression through no fault of their own. There is no reason to be ashamed of behavioral health issues and every reason to seek help as soon as possible. Also, like other health challenges that may occur, it is a good idea to get screened for depression if you feel you may be at risk. Screening is available at Red Cliff Community Health Center, or you can go online to [www.mhascreening.org](http://www.mhascreening.org) or visit [www.HelpYourselfHelpOthers.org](http://www.HelpYourselfHelpOthers.org) to take an online screening.

**Here are some tips that  
you can use to get your  
kids to drink more fat-free or low-  
fat (1%) milk**



Serve fat-free or low-

fat (1%) milk with meals and snacks. Put fat-free or low-fat (1%) milk at eye level in the refrigerator, so kids are more likely to see and ask for a glass or to have it poured over whole-grain cereal.

Add milk to some of your child's favorite foods, such as soups and oatmeal. For example, make creamy tomato soup instead of classic tomato soup by adding 1% fat milk.

Occasionally, let kids have some flavored fat free or low-fat (1%) milk. Compare nutrition labels at the store and choose flavored milks with the least amount of sugar.

**Enjoy a glass of low-fat  
milk or yogurt with your child. Or, make a parfait  
together by layering low-  
fat yogurt, your favorite fruit, and unsalted nuts or  
cereal. There are many types of low-  
fat milk foods, so there is something for everyone.**

Boozhoo, my name is Rachel Topping. I am a Red Cliff Tribal member and live here in the community. I have recently accepted the position as the Family Navigator within the Red Cliff Indian Child Welfare Department.

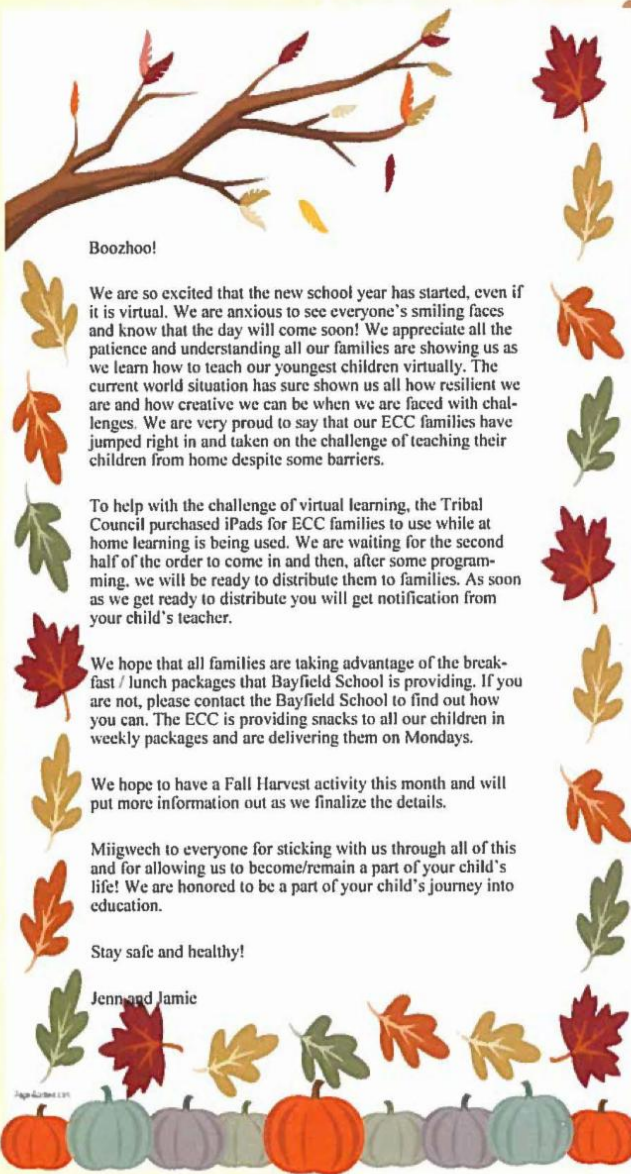

- Draft 1 to tribal departments and agency partners in January 2020
- Draft 2 released to the community in March 2020 with an open ended comment period
- Intended to have a community feast on April 1st, where we would have shared a presentation and had a time for discussion. Unfortunately, we had to postpone that event indefinitely due to COVID-19.
- We are now releasing Draft 3 along with short video presentations to the community with the hope that community members will review and provide feedback to help us finalize the plan.
- The current community comment period for this draft Plan is open until Oct 31. 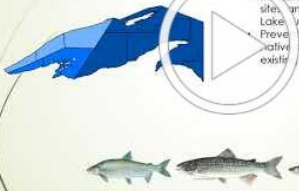
