The First Flag Raised Over Iwo Jima

On the morning of February 23, 1945, members of the 3rd Platoon, 28th Regiment, 5th Marine Division, were given orders to climb and secure Mount Suribachi. Upon reaching the top, five Marines raised the first American Flag on Japanese soil in the war. Afterward, a second larger



The first flag raising over Iwo Jima. Photo by Lou Lowery, 10 a.m., Feb. 23, 1945


flag, made famous by photographer Joe Rosenthal, replaced the first flag raised by the platoon that included Cpl. Chuck Lindberg. Chuck and his wife, Vi, lived in Richfield, Minnesota, for over 50 years. Chuck passed away on June 24, 2007, just before his 87th Birthday.

The Honoring All Veterans Memorial


Honoring All Veterans Memorial, Inc., a non-profit organization, has erected a monument to honor those Americans who have served their country in the United States Military. The Memorial is located in Veterans Memorial Park, 6400 Portland Avenue, in Richfield, Minnesota. Features of this exciting monument include:

Monument Centerpiece – The centerpiece of the monument features a lighted bronze statue of Chuck Lindberg and the American Flag.

Granite Memorial Tablets – Each granite tablet displays the engraved names of 240 Veterans. Each engraving displays the Veteran's name, branch of service and provides a symbol to recognize service members that were prisoners of war, killed in action or missing in action.

Columns of Stone and the Capture of Light -

The design of the Memorial features six columns, each representing a different US Military Branch. These columns curve inward toward the American Flag, symbolizing that our Military Branches bend but never break. Two glass prisms are mounted between two sets of columns to reflect sunlight



on the Memorial. The colorful light is meant to honor our Veterans with a full day's remembrance.

Memorial Engravings

The Honoring All Veterans Memorial is the perfect opportunity to individually recognize the contributions of those who have served our country in the military services. Be a part of the Memorial by having your name, or the veteran(s) of your choice, engraved on a granite memorial tablet.
