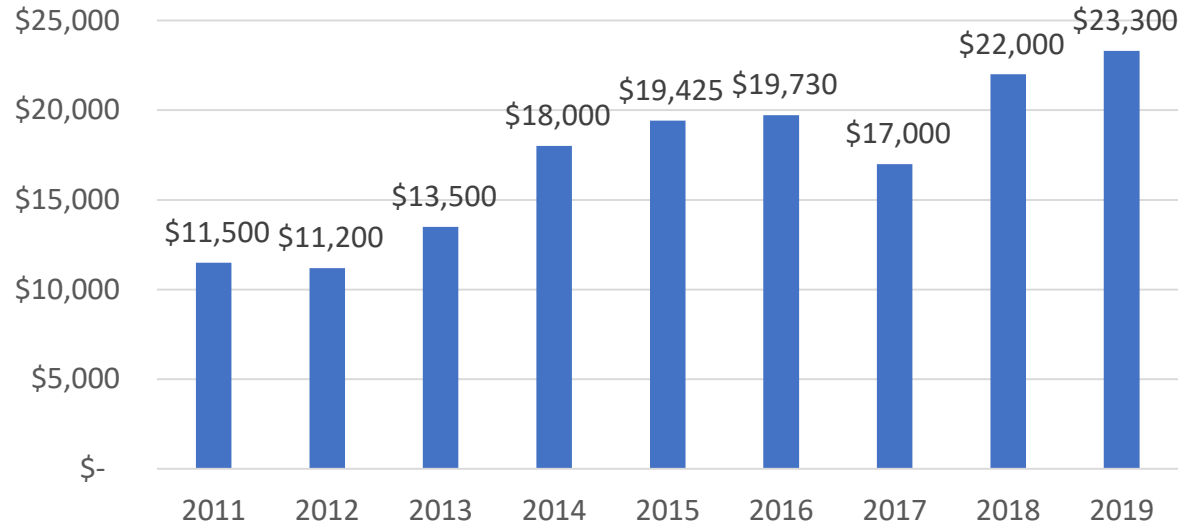

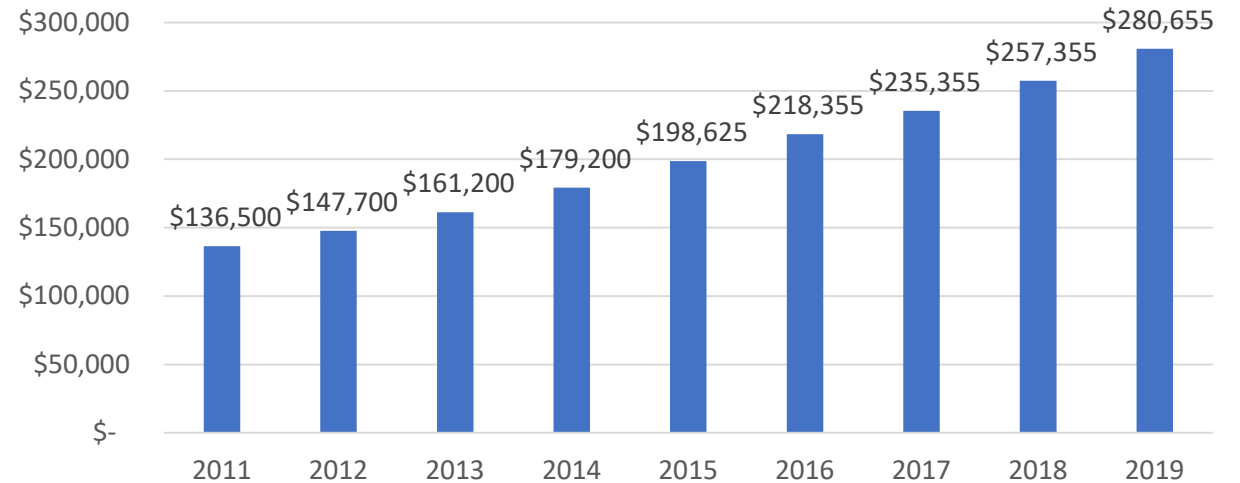


In 2020, Richfield Foundation granted out **\$48,765** to 20 organizations!
